Ireland experienced a golden age while the rest of Europe was going through the dark ages from 600 Ad to 900 Ad. It is safe to say that this Catholic culture has permeated Irish society from then right up to present day. But strangely, Ireland has a "mish-mash" in its spirituality.

Throughout history there have been innumerable ways to connect with the divine. Does God, or Spirit, or The Universe really care what we call him/her? Or if we don't believe at all. I have an open mind and realise that many paths lead to the same final destination. The same cannot be said for some of my fellow country men and women. But that is changing and fast. Still, in the mean-time if the bus is full and I need a seat, I can always just take my tarot cards out of my pocket...

Alas, why was the street so deserted? Did I arrive too early? There was a pittance of human activity, but nothing out of the ordinary for a Saturday morning in such a quiet little town. With the Prince of Cups driving me forward, I assaulted

this petite settlement, and stumbled across a very small sign. "Psychic Fair"! It pointed to the doorway of the small community hall.

I soon forgot my excitement and suddenly became quite nervous. I took a deep breath and reluctantly entered the hall. It was cordoned off into so many individual stalls. I felt several eyes suddenly incarcerate me, psychically interrogate and probe at my free spirit. I was drawn to Evelyn, a warm and friendly lady; a descendant from a Gypsy background. She was a Spiritual Medium/Clairvoyant and Tarot Reader. Wow, multi-skilled! A tiny little scruffy haired dog had attached herself to Evelyn, and although not her pet, looked totally in tune with Evelyn's soul. Although I sat at Evelyn's little round table, I couldn't help but notice the boxes of tissues on all the tables. Oh no, just what I suspected, the inevitable end to a reading – tears! I felt the Four of Swords coming on! The emotional force-field suddenly activated, and a cold chill passed through my body. Evelyn's body shivered as she looked me straight in the eye and said "Did you feel that?" I just forced a smile, and the little dog then jumped upon her lap, not the least bit threatened by me.

Evelyn handed me some black tourmaline to hold in my tense hands during the reading, explaining that it would draw the negative energy from my body. She had four piles of cards in front of her but I was so nervous I couldn't even recall the name or symbols of the deck she used! I know she revealed the Page of Cups, a new love in my life and lots of fun and happiness coming up. In all honesty I must have looked like a stunned mullet! I hardly spoke a word, but then, I was led to believe you weren't supposed to. I was so sure Evelyn had some difficulty reading me, or so I thought. At the end of the reading, Evelyn gave me a little white angel. She called it my "Worry Angel". Every time I was burdened with worries, I was to touch the little White Angel, and she would take on my anxieties. Evelyn took back the tourmaline stone and blew away all my worries. She gave me a big hug and reminded me to touch the Angel every now and then. I walked out of there in a daze. "Is it over?" I asked myself. I was

amazed, no tears, a little enlightened perhaps, but I doubted we connected like the Two Cups. I was happy to board my Chariot and head for home. It had been a very unusual and tiring day for me.

Strange how tarot urges you to look at what is happening in your life. It wasn't until I arrived home and relaxed a little before I started to make sense out of what Evelyn had said. It was as if the High Priestess was slowing unveiling her secrets. Wow, what a trip! # A Past Life's Learning Rebalanced

This is very much a topic that is subjective, some believe in past life and some do not.

My personal experiences and professional experiences have directed me to understand that past life debts is a real occurrence that warrants consideration. I read a statement one time that described how some Souls make a 'contract' with each other before their life begins. This allows them the opportunity to resolve past life issues with one another, Interesting concept?

It seems a very possible situation, it cannot be incidental or coincidence that we meet people in our life and feel that we have known them for years.

Some people come in and out of our lives and some people stay longer and some we learn from.

So how do we know that we have a past life debt?

Initially, it isn't always clear to see, often there is a 'connection' that is not easily explained. A feeling that we know this person and they will become important to us at some point and for some reason.

I am sure that most readers have experienced karmic relationships in their readings. Identifying such potentials within a relationship can allow the reader to offer often much needed guidance. The Devil card often makes his appearance when a bond is difficult to break away from.

Guidance in this situation can continue throughout the period, until finally, the break is made and we see the beginnings of independence.

Did the two people in this relationship have past life issues to work through? Quite possibly but cards will indicate as such, what we are looking at in this article is the actual realization of the learning to be found in the relationship and then move forward with one's life.

With this situation in mind, I asked my Tarot deck to give me 2 cards that represent a past life debt that is now paid.

Using the Tarot Illuminati, I was presented with the Hierophant and Justice with the 6 of Cups as the shadow card.

Interesting cards I thought to myself, Justice is a card that I have often considered as dealing with universal balance so her presence was not unexpected. The Hierophant was less expected and together they are not a combination that comes to me often. In fact, I probably would not have chosen this pairing for this situation but I am confident that together they will be a





The Hierophant asks us to question our beliefs, do we live by that which we profess to have faith in? Are we living by the example that we should be setting for ourselves and for others, after all, we know his guidance, we know how to choose moderation. Where we accept that the Hierophant can represent

our moral guide, we need to also keep in mind that one person's perspective on what is moral may be different to another person's. Likewise, one belief system will not be everyone's.

In card 2 we see Justice standing firm and undeterred, her scales held evenly with equal weight, her sword is upright, without falter. It is important not to forget that she weighs her balance without prejudice or bias nor opinion.

There is a satisfaction in this combination that the individual takes the path that will align him or herself in balance with the universe by choosing what is right ( for him or her) both internally and externally.

The pillars that set the structure are visible within each of the two cards, standing ever so firmly.

The 6 of Cups as the shadow card, indicates the past life situation that we are re-visiting at this current time.

I think that it is fair to say that if this pairing came out for a question of a debt repaid, I would think yes, it most certainly is.


# July Workshop at The Tarot Guild Australia

I recently facilitated a workshop in July 2016 at **The Tarot Guild Australia Victoria**: Tarot and Psychology of Relationships- a shortened form of the Tarot & Psychology Conference presentation in New York at the Readers Studio April 2016.

I drew 3 cards about the Workshop, to see what learning would come from the experience.







Wheel of Change Tarot Deck by Alexandra Genettii

### The cards— The Chariot, 10 Cups and Lover.

This shows movement and progress (Chariot) connecting to family, their past and present influence in the multi-generational family & repeated patterns of dynamics, especially the need for parental empathy (10 cups) manifesting in

current relationship dynamics, hopefully integrating and aiding more conscious choices in romantic relationships (Lovers). The Lovers literally showed the key topic and differentiation between the Self and Other (Genetti). The Chariot brings loss or gain in fortunes, depending on how power connects to the well-being of others, in relationship. (Genetti).

These cards synchronise well for the learning experience and relevance of the workshop: action with responsibility, influence of family, emotions and distilling self from the other, crucial for the client and the reader; balance and dynamism in the presentation, group contribution, sensitivity to feelings and a consciousness of the relationship between facilitator and audience.

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#### Post the workshop:

Participants explored their own or anonymous client's relationships with a spread about attachment style, and the balance of Parent/Child within a client and between partners, thus co- dependency or an unbalanced relationship. The Lovers card shows the need to do the 'inner child' work of integration, to seek higher guidance and have a shared vision of the relationship and to face the fearful aspects of the Ten of Cups e.g. enmeshment and the inter-generational dynamics.

Enthusiasm in the room, with to and fro energy from myself and the participants, the adolescent client energy in the pursuit of romance, but hopefully with balance and discernment, was present (Chariot). Participants liked the discussion about gently challenging clients (Chariot) about their tendency to rescue or continue in destructive relationships.

One person was able to go deeper than the literal meaning e.g. seeing sacrifice (Hanged Man) as part of rescuing.

The ethics of exploring the relationship, with only *one* partner present, concluded that focussing on the client's reading primarily, and their influence on the relationship, and to be less predictive about the partner's behaviour

e.g. are they having an affair? was key. The reader needs to be aware of their own projections and triggers.

The Parent Adult Child © JPerlstein 2015 spread was useful for experiencing the dynamic between two people.

As an example, the Chariot and The Fool in the respective Child positions, was used.

The Chariot may mean impulsive, forward moving behaviour from partner A, with open, maybe naive, overly trusting expectations/behaviour from Partner B, particularly as both are Major Arcana.

There may be tension, both wanting much emotionally, and Partner A impulsively 'rough shodding' over Partner B. Resources for healing would need to be drawn from the cards in the Parent and Adult positions for each individual and from the respective Partners.

We all continue on the path of these knotty and deep, complex relationship issues with our clients and ourselves!

# **Meditation on the High Priestess**

# **Fundamentals of Grounding**

There are many aspects of a reading that are important and often the querent comes first but what about us, the reader, who looks after us?

Looking after ourselves is a good foundation for a reading and one of the ways to achieve a good foundation is by being grounded.

Being grounded keeps us centred, keeps us in the present and gives us a personal strength like no other.

# What is grounding?

Grounding is a technique by which we connect our energy or consciousness and anchor it into the present. By doing this it can give us many benefits

- It brings us into the now
- Helps us to stay in our power and in our own energy
- Keeps us balanced and centred
- Helps tame the ego
- Regains control of our emotions
- Brings about focus

By having this energy planted firmly in our bodies it aligns us bringing clarity and higher wisdom.

Being 'off with the fairies' or being spaced out doesn't help connect us with higher realms it is in fact being grounded that lifts us higher. Raising our vibration is different to 'being spaced out'.

The firmer the roots the higher and stronger you can grow. Think how roots of a plant or tree support and nourish what they are producing!

We want to rid the chaotic, scattered, blurred or fuzzy feelings by having our roots, our energy, firmly planted and connected to the earth giving us a clear clean slate to work with.

### How to achieve a grounded state

#### Meditation

Meditation brings us into the present, meaning with a clear mind we stop thought about the future and the past. It centres us and lets us 'be'. Cyclic breathing also keeps our energy flowing.

A great way to enhance being grounded is to imagine tree roots running from the bottom of your feet, running deep into the earth grounding you to the core.

You can even imagine being grounded to a large earth crystal or an anchor firmly planting you into the ground.

#### Connection with Earth

Walk bare footed on the grass. Touch a tree, its leaves a flower. Dig in the dirt, plant something or just stop and take a deep breath outside. Being out in nature brings us back to our core, to our soul's rhythm.

#### **Exercise**

Walking, Yoga and weight work are very grounding. Or just generally doing something physical and getting your body moving. Doing exercise reminds us that we have a physical body.

#### **Eating**

Eating root vegetables such as Parsnips, Carrots, Sweet potato, Daikon or Turnips. Or have a glass of water, a cup of tea, some good quality chocolate or nuts.

#### **Crystals**

Have grounding crystals around you while you do your readings or meditate with these

Black Tourmaline - Grounding and protection
Black Obsidian - Grounding and cleansing
Red Jasper - Grounding and energy boosting
Hematite - Grounding and mind stimulating
Smoky Quartz - Grounding and both psychical and psychic protection

#### **Chakras**

If you're familiar with your Chakra system imagine a great cord of light running from the divine source through your body and flowing down deep into the earth.

### **Aromatherapy Oils**

Burning essential oils is a great way to balance out our energy and calm the mind. These oils are not just great for grounding they also evoke other healing qualities.

Sandalwood (Santalum album): Calms and harmonises the emotional body Frankincense (Boswellia carteri): Helps disconnect from mental chatter, uplifting, balancing Cedar (Cedrus altanica): Calming, purifying and grounding. Myrrh (Commiphora myrrha) Grounding, healing, protective and purifying

### **Grounding Fast!**

Grounding doesn't need to be a long drawn out process, for instance we can ground quickly in between readings just by having the intent, by saying the words "I am grounded" and imagining you are being anchored into the earth, feeling the pull of the earth's gravity.

Whichever way feels right for you use it in your daily life and the clarity will come flowing. Bringing your own energy into yourself brings back your power and it will not only benefit you it will benefit your reading.

# **Referring Back to the Question**



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# What's in Your Bag?

As someone that reads tarot all the time, I've started to have a packed bag or case for appointments, and a box for fairs/expos. I'm going to share with you what I have, and my suggestions of what to pack for each.

In my appointment bag I have:

- ❖ Tarot deck, minimum 1 but probably a couple for to choose from
- Pens, pencils paper, notebook, you or the questioner may want to write notes. You may also journal the reading
- Appointment book to ensure you are at the appointment on time, and the right place. You may also make a follow up appointment
- Business cards always always take business cards.
- Card reading mat or card reading cloth protects the cards, and gives a better appearance to the client. A nice cloth also helps with the read to create focus.
- Tissues
- ❖ Breath mints you will be talking, and probably up close and personal



In my fair expo bag I have all of the above plus:

More decks – more readings mean I may need to change decks, also different questions or different people may seem better suited to another deck. I like to have a mix of the decks, a slightly lighter fun deck, and a slightly more direct/blunt deck. Know your audience. What are the taboos or considered off limits?

What themes or styles do they like? If a party or convention, is there a prevalent theme?

**Timer** – with one on ones a clock is usually available. With fairs you will be doing multiple reads which are usually time based. Cell phone timer app or kitchen timer will work. I will be using a sand timer.

**Pretties** – 1 or 2 pretty objects, maybe a statue, maybe a nice stone. Be careful not to overkill. Too many pretties tend to be distracting to the client. Do include one or two items for mood, but don't overwhelm the senses, and don't get confused for a store.

**Tissues** – where you might need tissues at a one on one appointment, at a fair/expo event I can guarantee you will need tissues for your someone

**Light** – I find I like to have either a candle, lamp, or light to give a little more light to the cards, both for to see them visually, focus, and atmosphere. Know the safety rules of the venue concerning electric lighting and open flame.


**Snacks and water**: at expos and fairs you will be reading all day. So you want a couple easy to grab foods. I suggest protein bars, peanuts, beef jerky as they are easy and have high protein which is important. Grapes and fruits that are not overly juicy are good. Small chopped vegetables make a good snack as well. Water of course is best not only for your thirst, but you will be talking a lot, all day.

**Signage** – have signage to let people know who you are, what you do, and pricing and rates at the minimum.
